Dutch


Goodmorning, Ondrej!

PIN madness



Paying with the PIN-code



Too much money
on you is now

You don't need
more than a card

Everywhere else

You pay **by card**

Even if you pay by **phone** or **watch** or **ring** or whatever else

Since **contactless** era (2015+), **PIN-code** is often not necessary

The Netherlands

You pay **by the PIN-code**

Even if you **don't type** any PIN-code anywhere

Unless it is a credit card, then you **pay by creditcard**, just like the rest of the world
